

What are the dust protection requirements for cable trays

- Sealed joints and fittings:** Proper sealing at tray connections prevents dust penetration.
- Material selection:** Aluminum, steel, or coated metals with smooth surfaces reduce dust accumulation and facilitate cleaning.
- Ventilation control:** While some trays are ventilated for heat dissipation, dustproof trays may use filtered vents or minimal perforations to balance airflow and protection.

Testing Methods

Dustproof performance is verified through standardized testing:

- Laboratory Dust Ingress Test:** Simulates dusty environments to check if particles penetrate the tray.
- Field Testing:** Evaluates tray performance in actual installation conditions.
- Inspection and Maintenance:** Regular checks ensure that seals, covers, and joints remain intact and effective.
