Wire Size and Material For grounding distribution boxes, the ground wire size depends on the market and application: in the US, a 10 AWG (5.26 mm²) copper wire is standard, while in other international markets, a 6 mm² wire is commonly used . For connections between mounting plates and spindle plates in industrial setups, larger wires such as 16 mm² (or 6 AWG / 13.29 mm² in the US) are recommended to maintain low resistance and ensure proper grounding . Copper is the preferred material due to its high conductivity and corrosion resistance, though copper-clad steel may be used in some medium-voltage applications . Installation and Bonding Grounding requires secure connections from the distribution box to the mounting plate and then to the central grounding point. All threaded studs or dedicated ground bars should be used, avoiding double-tapping neutrals . The equipment grounding conductor (EGC) must run alongside all circuit conductors within the same raceway or cable to minimize impedance and ensure rapid fault current dissipation . For industrial or multi-spindle setups, parallel grounding paths may be used to reduce total resistance, calculated as the parallel combination of tool cable and ground wire resistances . Resistance Requirements The total ground resistance between all system parts should be less than 0.1 ohm for industrial equipment, while residential or commercial distribution boxes typically require less than 25 ohms for effective grounding . Testing each installation is critical, and multiple rods or continuous conductors may be needed if resistance exceeds the li...

Each DISTRIBUTION BOX and controller must be grounded. On the US market, a 5.26 mm² (10 AWG) ground wire must be used, and in all other markets a 6 mm² must be used.
