- Testing and Documentation:** Annexes cover loss-budget calculations, field-test requirements, and references to other relevant standards.

The ANSI/TIA-568.3-E standard focuses on premises optical fiber cabling, specifying performance, transmission, and test requirements for cables, connectors, and patch cords. Key updates include:
