Wire Preparation: Strip the insulation from the ends of the wires, leaving enough exposed conductor for secure terminal connections. Use color coding: phase/live (brown/red), neutral (blue/black), and ground (green/yellow) ().

Connecting the Main Power: Attach the incoming live wire to the main terminal, neutral to the neutral busbar, and ground to the grounding terminal. Ensure all connections are tight and secure ().

Installing Circuit Breakers: Place circuit breakers in their designated slots. Connect each outgoing circuit wire to its corresponding breaker, following the wiring diagram and load requirements ().

Wiring Outgoing Circuits: Connect equipment or branch circuits to the output terminals. Maintain neat wire management using cable ties and leave space for heat dissipation. Avoid tangling or contact with sharp edges ().
