

What is NFMC Network MC Bridge



AI Overview

NFMC (Network MC Bridge) is a technology that combines Near Field Magnetic Communication with network bridging to enable secure, short-range data transfer between devices.

Overview NFMC (Near Field Magnetic Communication) is a communication method that uses magnetic induction to transmit data over very short distances, typically a few centimeters to a few meters. Unlike traditional wireless communication that relies on radio frequency (RF) waves, NFMC generates a magnetic field via a transmitting coil, which induces a voltage in a receiving coil, allowing data to be transferred efficiently and securely. A Network MC Bridge integrates this NFMC capability with the concept of a network bridge, a Layer 2 device that connects and filters traffic between two or more network segments. In essence, it acts as a bridge for NFMC-enabled devices, allowing them to communicate as part of a larger network while maintaining collision-free data transfer and efficient bandwidth usage.

How It Works

Magnetic Induction Transmission: The transmitting coil generates an alternating current (AC) signal, creating a fluctuating magnetic field.

Data Reception: The receiving coil detects the magnetic field and converts it back into an electrical signal, reconstructing the transmitted data.

Network Bridging: The NFMC bridge inspects incoming data packets, determines the destination device or network segment, and forwards the data accordingly, similar to how a traditional network bridge uses MAC addresses to route traffic. This combination allows multiple NFMC devices to communicate seamlessly within a network, extending connectivity while reducing interference and collisions.
