

# What kind of fiber optic patch cord is the user using

- Plenum (OFNP): Fire-resistant, suitable for air ducts.
- Riser (OFNR): For vertical shafts between floors.
- LSZH: Low smoke, zero halogen, common in Europe or high-safety areas.

**Duplex vs Simplex**

- Simplex: One fiber, one-way communication.
- Duplex: Two fibers, two-way communication (Tx/Rx), most Ethernet and PON links use duplex.

**How to Identify Your Patch Cord**

- Check the fiber core color: Yellow for single-mode, orange for OM1/OM2, aqua for OM3/OM4, lime green or violet for OM5.
- Inspect the connectors: LC, SC, ST, or MTP/MPO.
- Look at the jacket markings: Material type (PVC, LSZH, OFNR, OFNP) and any fire code compliance.
- Measure the distance and application: Single-mode for long reach, multimode for short intra-data center runs.

By combining these characteristics—fiber type, connector type, jacket material, and application—you can accurately classify the fiber optic patch cord you...
