Aluminum trays are lightweight and corrosion-resistant, suitable for outdoor or humid environments. While aluminum has good thermal conductivity, it is less fire-resistant than fire-coated steel and may require additional protective measures in high-risk areas (ZeroInstrument) .Non-Metallic Cable TraysFiber-reinforced plastic (GRP) trays are non-combustible, self-extinguishing, and halogen-free, making them highly fire-resistant. They do not release toxic gases when exposed to heat and are suitable for chemical plants, industrial facilities, and sensitive environments.
