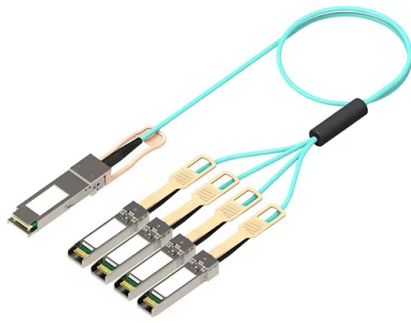


What s wrong with network rack patch cords
