

What size should the incoming cable for the distribution box be

The size of the incoming cable to a distribution box depends on the system voltage, load current, and number of phases, typically using a five-wire system for three-phase setups or three-wire for single-phase, with wire gauge selected according to current-carrying capacity.

The selection should follow standards such as NEC, IEC, or local codes, considering factors like insulation type, ambient temperature, and installation method.

For example: Lighting or small power circuits: typically use smaller gauge wires (e.g., 2.5–4 mm² for single-phase lighting circuits in residential setups). High-power or industrial loads: require larger conductors (e.g., 10–35 mm² or more) depending on current and distance from the supply source.

Installation Considerations Ensure proper grounding and connection to neutral and phase terminals. Maintain adequate bending radius for incoming cables to avoid mechanical stress. Use circuit breakers or air switches rated for the incoming current. Leave sufficient space in the distribution box for wiring, future expansion, a...
