

What stripping method is used for single-core drop optical cables

Mechanical Stripping The most common method for single-core drop cables is mechanical stripping using handheld fiber strippers. - Buffer stripping:** The primary coating or buffer is removed using a fiber stripper or buffer stripping tool, exposing the bare glass fiber for splicing or connectorization.

Thermal and Non-Contact Methods For some applications, thermo-mechanical strippers are used. These tools soften the polymer coating with heat before mechanical removal, reducing the risk of nicking the fiber. Non-contact methods, such as hot air or laser ablation, are less common for single-core drop cables but may be used in specialized environments where precision is critical.

Chemical Stripping Chemical stripping using solvents or acids is generally reserved for laboratory or specialty fibers. It involves dissolving the polymer coating to expose the glass fiber, but it is less practical for field installations due to handling and safety concerns.

Best Practices Always strip progressively, starting from the outer jacket to the inner buffer, to avoid fiber damage. Use lint-free wipes and high-purity alcohol to clean the bare fiber after stripping. Inspect the fiber...
