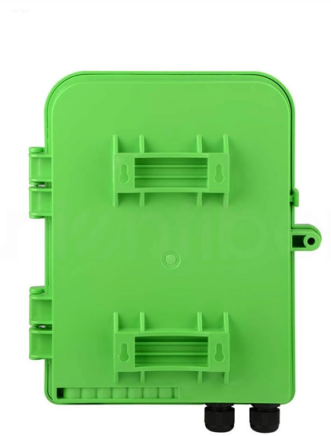


When are cable trays installed

Adequate clearance must be maintained for cable pulling and future maintenance (). Routes should avoid interference with structural elements, HVAC systems, and other utilities ().

Installation of Trays Cable trays are mounted using appropriate supports and hangers, following manufacturer specifications and structural requirements. Ladder trays are commonly used for power cables due to their ventilation and support, while ventilated troughs are suitable for smaller control or instrumentation cables (). Supports must be spaced according to tray type and load, and trays should be level and securely fastened ().
