Connector End The factory-terminated connector end of the pigtail is designed for immediate connection to network devices, optical transceivers, patch panels, or Optical Distribution Frames (ODFs) without additional preparation. This end ensures low insertion loss and high return loss because it is polished and tested under controlled factory conditions. Bare Fiber End The bare fiber end is intended for permanent splicing to the incoming fiber cable. This can be done using either fusion splicing or mechanical splicing:

- Fusion Splicing:** Uses a fusion splicer to melt the two fiber ends together, creating a seamless optical path. This method provides the lowest signal loss and highest reliability. After splicing, a heat-shrink splice protection sleeve is applied to protect the fragile joint.
- Mechanical Splicing:** Aligns the fiber ends in a precision device, allowing light to pass through. This method is simpler and faster but may have slightly higher insertion loss compared to fusion splicing. Before splicing, the bare fiber must be stripped, cleaved at a precise 90-degree angle, and cleaned with lint-free wipes and isopropyl alcohol to ensure optimal performance.

- Optical Distribution Frames (ODFs):** The connector end plugs into the ODF port, while the bare end is spliced to the backbone or incoming fiber.
- Terminal Boxes or Splice Closures:** The connector end connects to patch cords or equipment, and the bare end is spliced to the main fiber cable.
