How Fiber Connects to a Router Most standard home routers do not accept fiber optic cables directly because the optical signal must first be converted into an electrical signal. This conversion is handled by an Optical Network Terminal (ONT), which is usually provided by your Internet Service Provider (ISP) and installed near the fiber entry point in your home or office . The fiber cable plugs into the ONT's optical port, which then outputs data through a standard Ethernet port to your router .
