Inspect with magnifiers, optical loops, or video inspection tools to remove dust and contaminants. Keep protective dust caps on all connectors and equipment ports to prevent contamination.
- Environmental Control** Maintain operating environments within recommended temperature and humidity levels. Protect outdoor cables with conduits or bury them at sufficient depth (typically 1.5 meters) to prevent physical damage. Consider armored cables in harsh or high-traffic areas.
- Monitoring and Testing** Use OTDR (Optical Time-Domain Reflectometer) traces or insertion loss testing selectively, primarily after installation or when stress is suspected. Rely on network equipment monitoring for real-time performance indicators rather than frequent physical inspections.
