Blinking or Solid Red: Loss of signal due to fiber disconnection, damaged cable, dirty connector, or ISP outage. Troubleshoot by checking fiber connections and rebooting the router.
- LAN (Ethernet) Light**
Flickering: Active wired connection with data transfer.
Off: No device connected or faulty LAN port/cable.
- WLAN / Wi-Fi Light**
Flickering: Wireless activity is occurring.
Off: Wi-Fi is disabled in router settings or not broadcasting.
- Internet / WAN Light**
Solid Green/Blue: Router is connected to the internet.
Flashing Green/Blue: Data is being transmitted or received.
Red/Amber or Off: No internet connection; may indicate ISP issues or misconfigured WAN settings.
- WPS Light (if available)**
Blinking: Router is in pairing mode, ready to connect devices.
Solid: WPS connection established.
Off: WPS inactive.

Troubleshooting Tips
Restart the Router: Power cycle by unplugging for 30 seconds and reconnecting.
Check Connections: Ensure fiber, LAN, and power cables are securely connected.
Inspect Fiber Cable: Look for bends, cuts, or damage.
Reset Router: Use the reset button if issues persist, but note this will erase custom settings.
Contact ISP: If lights indicate a persistent problem, your ISP may need to check the network or replace faulty equipment.

Understanding these LED indicators allows you to quickly identify whether your router is functioning correctly or if there is a connection issue.
