- 3. Fiber-Optic Cables** Fiber-optic cables transmit data as light pulses through glass or plastic fibers, enabling high-speed communication over long distances with minimal signal loss. They are ideal for internet backbones, telecommunications, and applications requiring electrical isolation. Fiber-optic cables are immune to EMI and support very high bandwidths.
- 4. Electrical and Control Cables** These include single-core and multi-core cables for power transmission, control, and automation. Examples include:
 - CY Cable:** Flexible, screened cables with tinned copper braid, suitable for indoor and temporary outdoor use.
 - SY Cable:** Armored flexible control cables with galvanized steel wire braid, providing durability for industrial environments.
