- Circuit Protection:** Each branch circuit must have a properly rated breaker to prevent overloads or short circuits.
- Grounding and Bonding:** Connect all non-current-carrying metal parts to the equipment grounding conductor and a dedicated grounding electrode system. This ensures a low-impedance path for fault currents ().
- GFCI Protection:** Required for all 125V, single-phase receptacles used by personnel to prevent electric shock.
- Cable Management:** Route and dress cables neatly to avoid damage, tangling, or tripping hazards ().

Safety and Standards

- Use IP-rated connectors (e.g., IP67) for waterproofing and durability ().
- Follow IEC 61439 for low-voltage switchgear and IEC 60364 for electrical installations to ensure compliance ().
