

Wiring Method for Portable Power Distribution Box

Step 5: Connect Outlets Wire your 120V or 240V outlets to the circuit breakers. Ensure that each outlet is rated for the intended load. For larger equipment, use 30A or 50A outlets as needed.

Step 6: Grounding and Safety Checks Connect all ground wires to the ground bus bar. Verify that the box is properly grounded to prevent electrical hazards. Test all GFCI or RCCB modules by pressing the test button to ensure they trip correctly.

Step 7: Test the System Before connecting equipment, turn on the main breaker and check each branch circuit. Confirm that all outlets are live and that protective devices function...
