 - Enclosure Material:** Stainless steel (Baosteel 304 or higher) or aluminum is preferred for mechanical strength and corrosion resistance. The box thickness should meet minimum standards (e.g., ≥ 4 mm for stainless steel).
 - Certifications:** Ensure the box and components have ATEX, IECEx, or NEMA certifications to validate suitability for explosive atmospheres.
