

# Wiring of PKC module in electrical cabinet

The PKC module should be wired with careful attention to input types, shielding, grounding, and separation from power lines to ensure accurate measurements and safe operation.

**Mounting and Physical Installation** The PKC module can be mounted on a panel up to 15 mm thick, using a cutout of 92 x 45 mm for the PKC model. Ensure the module is securely fixed and accessible for wiring and maintenance.

**Input Wiring**

- Auxiliary Inputs:** Follow the same shielding and separation rules as other inputs. Avoid routing these wires with power lines.

**Logic and Current Transformer Inputs**

- Logic Inputs (IN5-IN8):** Connect according to the module's logic diagram. Keep wiring separate from power cables to prevent interference.
- Current Transformer Inputs:** Wire CTs carefully, ensuring proper polarity and separation from high-voltage lines.

**General Wiring Practices**

- Separation of Power and Signal Lines:** Always route power cables separately from signal and sensor wires to reduce noise and measurement errors.
- Grounding:** Ground shields at one end only. Ensure the cabinet has a proper earth connection for safety and signal integrity.
- Terminal Blocks:** Use terminal blocks to organize connections and simplify troubleshooting.
- Labeling:** Clearly label all wires and terminals for easy identification during maintenance or future upgrades.

**Integration with PLC Cabinet** When wiring the PKC module inside a PLC or control cabinet: Connect the power supply first, then signal and input/output lines. Maintain adequate spacing for ventilation and future expansion. Follow relevant...
