- Bus Bars:** Conductive strips that distribute power to multiple breakers; typically include neutral and ground bars for proper grounding ().
- Incoming Power Feed:** Connects the panel to the utility transformer or main service line ().

Wiring Process

- Safety First:** Turn off the main power supply and verify with a voltage tester before starting any wiring ().
- Plan Circuit Layout:** Determine the number of circuits, their load requirements, and wire paths. Ensure adequate space in the panel for all breakers ().
- Install Breakers:** Each breaker corresponds to a specific circuit. Insert them into the panel according to the planned layout ().
- Connect Wires:** Hot wires (live) connect to the breaker terminals. Neutral wires connect to the neutral bus bar. Ground wires connect to the ground bus bar ().
- Label Circuits:** Clearly mark each breaker to indicate the area or appliance it controls for easier troubleshooting ().
- Check Connections:** Ensure all wires are securely fastened, with no exposed conductors, and that the panel meets local electrical codes ().
