- Neutral (N) Wire:** For 1P breakers, connect the neutral wire directly to the neutral busbar. For 2P breakers, connect the neutral to the breaker's designated terminal.
- Protective Earth (PE) Wire:** Connect the earth wire to the ground busbar. For breakers with RCD or RCBO protection, ensure the PE wire is properly linked to the breaker's terminal to protect against earth faults.

Circuit Breaker Installation Install individual breakers for each circuit according to load requirements. Ensure tight connections and correct polarity. Use DIN rails if available for mounting breakers and other modular devices.

Cable Management Strip wires to the correct length and avoid excessive exposure. Route wires neatly, secure with ca...
