

Wiring the PE wire terminal of the distribution box

The PE (Protective Earth) wire should be securely connected to the PE bar or grounding terminal in the distribution box using a properly prepared copper wire and tightened screw connection. Identifying the PE Terminal Open the distribution box and locate the PE bar or terminal, usually marked with "PE" or a grounding symbol. Preparing the PE Wire Use a yellow-green insulated copper wire with a cross-sectional area meeting local electrical standards. Strip the insulation for the required length to expose the copper conductor. Crimp a ring terminal onto the stripped end to ensure a secure mechanical and electrical connection. Connecting the PE Wire Place the ring terminal over the PE terminal screw. Use the specified screw (e.g., M4 or M3 depending on the distribution box) and tighten to the recommended torque (e.g., 0.5 Nm) to avoid loose connections or damage. Ensure the screw does not protrude into the interior of the box, which could cause short circuits or damage to components. Grounding Electrical Components If there are devices or components inside the distribution box that require grounding, connect them to the PE bar using additional copper wires. This ensures that all exposed conductive parts are bonded to the protective earth, providing a safe path for fault currents. Safety and Maintenance Verify that all PE connections are firm and free of looseness. Clearly mark the PE connections for easy inspection and maintenance. Avoid running PE wires through ferromagnetic materials or far from live conductors in TN or IT systems to minimize inductive reactance.
