Use Proper Connectors If using push-in or splicing connectors, ensure they are rated for copper conductors and the correct cross-section (e.g., 0.5–2.5 mm² for typical domestic wiring). Avoid over-inserting or repeatedly removing wires to prevent wear on the tin plating of the copper plate, which can increase contact resistance and overheating
