

Zinc plating solution for cable trays



AI Overview

Cable trays can be protected using electro-galvanized zinc plating, hot-dip galvanizing, or advanced zinc-magnesium (ZM) coatings, each offering different corrosion resistance and application benefits.

Electro-Galvanized Zinc Plating Electro-galvanizing deposits a thin, uniform layer of zinc onto steel via electrolysis. This method produces a bright, smooth finish suitable for indoor or less aggressive environments. Standards for electro-galvanized cable trays are defined in GB/T 26941.1-2011, which specifies coating thickness and uniformity requirements. While the corrosion resistance is lower than hot-dip galvanizing, modern electro-zinc coatings like EZ1000 provide enhanced protection, achieving over 1,000 hours of salt spray resistance, making them suitable for data centers, commercial buildings, and industrial facilities where moisture or corrosive elements are present. The smooth surface also reduces the risk of cable damage and mitigates zinc whisker formation, which is critical for sensitive electronic equipment.

Hot-Dip Galvanizing Hot-dip galvanizing involves submerging steel components into molten zinc, forming a zinc-iron alloy layer and a pure zinc layer. This produces a thicker, highly adherent coating with superior corrosion resistance, ideal for harsh environments such as outdoor, coastal, or heavy industrial applications. Standards are specified in GB/T 13912-2020, with minimum local thicknesses of $45\mu\text{m}$ for tray sheets and $\geq 55\mu\text{m}$ for heavier components. Hot-dip galvanizing ensures long-term durability and is widely used for cable trays exposed to aggressive conditions.

Zinc-Magnesium (ZM) Coatings ZM coatings combine zinc, magnesium, and aluminum to provide corrosion protection comparable to hot-dip galvanizing while offering additional benefits. The ZM finish forms a dense, self-healing protective film over the steel, including cut edges and scratches, enhancing longevity and reducing maintenance. It also reduces carbon footprint by eliminating the need for post-galvanizing processes and shortens lead t...
